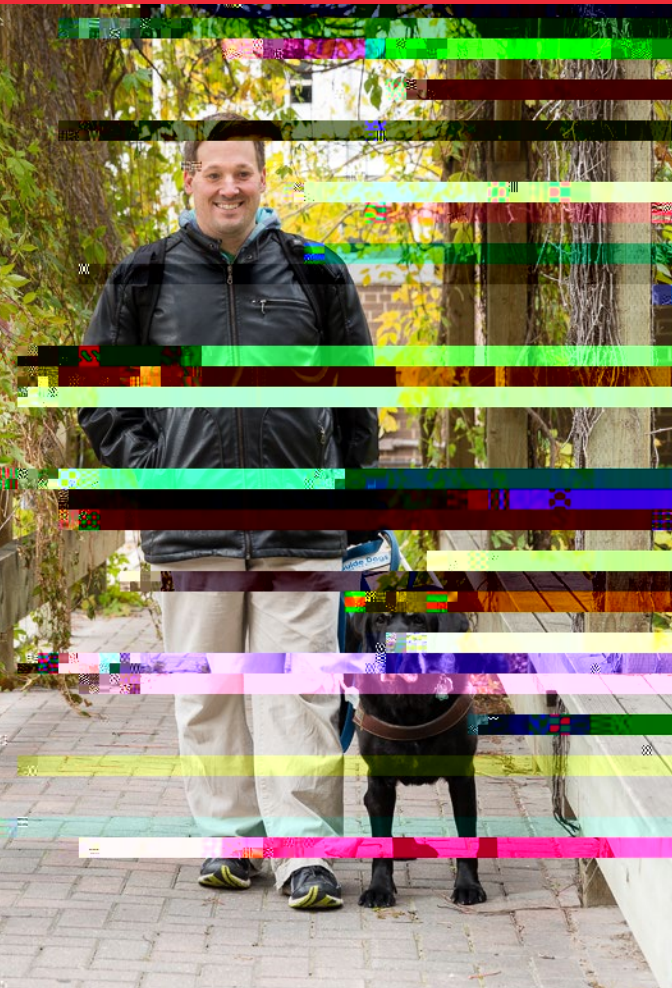

Examples of Academic Accommodations

Classroom accommodations:

- A student with a learning disability may need extra time to complete assignments or tests.
- A student with a physical disability may need a wheelchair accessible desk or a desk with a raised surface.
- A student with a hearing impairment may need a sign language interpreter or a hearing aid.
- A student with a visual impairment may need a large print font or a screen reader.
- A student with a mental health condition may need a quiet room or a break during class.
