

**In order to obtain a Bachelor of Arts Degree from the University of Winnipeg students must complete an additional 60 credit hours of course work (students will receive standing in 30 credit hours on the basis of completing the two year ECE diploma). Within these 60 credit hours, students must complete the Major in Developmental Studies, and must fulfill the Humanities, Science, and Indigenous course requirements.**

**Upon successful completion of the program, students may apply to the Manitoba Early Learning and Child Day Care Program (Manitoba Department of Families) for Early Childhood Educator (ECE) III classification.**
