This policy is in addition to

the Special Consideration category only must include a 12 page written statement describing the factors that have prevented them from achieving a competitive GPA (see Expanded Admission Policy Information Handout).

Students applying for Expanded Admission to the first year of the Integrated Program must meet minimum admission requirements. Students applying for Expanded Admission as Transfer or After-Degree candidates must meet minimum admission requirements and have a minimum GPA of 2.0.
